## Junior High- What's Different?

Daily Phy. Ed. - All students must change for PE including shirts, shorts/tights & runners.

Block Schedule - Students will likely have a variety of teachers. Start and dismissal times are different but we still provide 950 hours of instruction, same as elementary.

Homeroom - Students are assigned to a class and travel with that class with the exception of option classes.

Lockers - Students store their books, backpacks & jackets in their locker. We supply locks.

Lunch & Breaks - Kids choose where they eat. Students may leave the school at lunch with parent permission. Supervision takes place within the school. Students may purchase food from the cafeteria.

Arrival at School - Kids may enter the school when they arrive. They have free time until the music plays to signal the start of the day.

#### Junior High- What's Different?

Phones - Students are permitted to have a phone at school but must turn them off when they enter class and must receive teacher permission to use as a learning tool in class.

Our Dress Code - Modest dress that fits our morals & values including no hats except for special days. Please see handbook.

Updates from Kids - They may not share much from their day, ex. "Good" "Nuthin" "It's alright"

Be sure to Ask - Staff teach upwards of 225 kids a year in different classes and options. Please call or email if you have a question or concern.

Help - There is always help for students & parents who need it. You have only to ask.






